Experience More Living History in the Sanitary Fair, Washburn Mansion, Universalist Meetinghouse, Washburn Memorial Library, Presentations Tent, Refreshments Tent, and at the Battlefield. Wagon Rides are available when the horses are not resting. It's a steep walk, but just past the Schoolhouse is the Water's Hill Cemetery, where Civil War veterans are laid to rest.

Stop by the Information Booth to learn about the Norlands' Barn Raising Campaign or to get the scoop on what's happening where and when at the Civil War reenactment. The refreshment booths and gift shop will be open all day.

Also Participate in the Town Ball Game, One-Room Schoolhouse, Sewing Circle in the Norlands' Kitchen, Ham and Bean Supper, Contra Dance with *Racket Factory* and Write a Letter to the Soldiers at the Post Office.

Don't miss the special talks by Kerck Kelsey on the Washburn Family History and Their Roles in the Civil War. And the Patriotic Concert by Mitch Thomas and Friends.

Things you might find in the Union Camp: Recruiting, Music, Sanitary Inspection.

Things you might find in the Confederate Camp: Dress Up and Photos (Bring Your Own Camera), Period Toys, Recruiting.

What you might find at the Presentations Tent: Victorian Calisthenics, 19th Century Fashion Show, "Meet Mercy Lovejoy", Kite Making, Children's Games, Timber Framing and more.

Things you might find at the Sanitary Fair: Authors of Civil War themed books, Soldiers Aid Society, herbal products and herbs, quilting demonstration, raffles, treats, exhibits of oddities and artifacts by the Fifth ME and Livermore-Livermore Falls Historical Society, personal collections of items such as "butter chips", the Post Office, and more!
